## MOTION FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ESSEN, GERMANY, ON 25 AUGUST 1995

"Council members are well aware that, in the present transitional period, it will be extremely difficult to follow all constitutional provisions, recognising especially the difficulty of combining 'Option 1' with the provisions of the present Constitution<sup>1</sup>. However, where possible, they will always work within its bounds. The Council recognizes that nominations for the new Council were not in strict accordance with the present Constitution. Nevertheless, the elections were validated unanimously by those attending the Business Meeting."

We ask you therefore for patience and your support.

## MINUTES OF THE BUSINESS MEETING OF THE SOCIETAS INTERNATIONALIS ODONATOLOGICA

held in the Department of Biology, State University of Essen, Germany on Thursday, 24 August 1995

Chairman: Jill Silsby; Recorders: Kate Miller, Ronnie Silsby

The meeting was convened at 15.10 hours. 63 members were present.

<sup>1</sup> Prof. Dr. B. Kiauta requested the SIO membership "for opinion on the future publication modalities and scope of the SIO mainstream journals" (enclosure to Odonatologica 23(2):

Option 1: "ORIGINAL (Kiauta). - I am to continue ODONATOLOGICA and NOTULAE at the present frequency and scope, incl. ODONATOLOGICAL ABSTRACTS. I am to produce these for SIO, but at my own financial risk and responsibility. The members will enjoy the subscription discount as heretofore, and free (or at a reduced rate) copies will be rendered to the membership in the Third World and (Ex-)Socialist countries, according to the same principles as during the past 23 years. In addition, I will give annually for Councils' disposal a certain lump-sum, based on the number of membership subscriptions paid in western currencies, and which is to be used by Council for financing of some of the other SIO activities. In short, SIO retains a certain "concern" in the 2 periodicals, but these are produced outside of the SIO financial control, responsibility and risk."

"If this option was to be adopted, the membership would not notice any de facto change". Membership adopted Option 1.

1. Minutes of the previous Meeting held at Osaka, Japan on 5 August 1993 had been published in *Selysia*, May 1994.

Approval proposed by Bastiaan Kiauta, seconded by Jean-Guy Pilon & Carried.

## 2. Matters arising.

Heinrich Lohmann requested that the Special Topic Group working on Systematic & Phylogenetic Odonatology be formally recognised. He reported that much valuable work was being carried out and that the Group would shortly be publishing a Journal which would incur no expense for SIO.

Acceptance of formal recognition was proposed by E. Schmidt, seconded by J.-G. Pilon & Carried.

## 3. Approval of modified Agenda.

The Agenda had been printed in the Abstract Booklet and had been a little enlarged & modified as presented to the Meeting.

Acceptance proposed by W. Schneider, seconded by J.-G. Pilon & Carried.

## 4. Report of the Secretary General.

- Mike May reported that in the two years since Osaka, aspects of the structure of SIO which need improvement had been highlighted.

- At the two Council meetings held earlier in the week, issues had been dealt with as follows:

→ the present Constitution still holds, apart from "Option 1", although changes are being proposed;

→ Wolfgang Schneider would be appointed by the new Council (1995-7) to head a Working Group deputed to work on a revised Constitution which would be presented at the 14th Symposium in 1997; preliminary proposals would be ready by July 1996;

→ it had been suggested that, following the example described under Item 2 above, further Special Topic Working Groups should be set up [see Item 16(e)].

Acceptance of the Secretary's Report was proposed by M. Kotarac, seconded by N. Moore & Carried.

## 5. Report of the President.

- Eberhard Schmidt was firmly of the opinion that the financial affairs of the Journals should be separated from those of the SIO itself, in accordance with the result of the 1994 Referendum that had been put to the membership (Option 1).

- He regretted that communication had not always been good but hoped that things would be better for his successor.

Acceptance of the President's Report was proposed by H. Lohmann, seconded by P. Corbet & Carried.

## 6. Report of the Executive Editor.

- Bastiaan Kiauta reported that, since the Osaka Meeting two years before, 8 issues of *Odonatologica* had been published, containing 77 papers by about 80 authors. He added that for approximately half of these, it was their first paper in the Journal which indicated that new authors were being attracted. He regretted that Abstract coverage had become less extensive.

- He further reported that, owing to the ill health of Jean Legrand, the Osaka volume of *Advances in Odonatology* had been delayed, but that it had now been taken over by Carlo Utzeri and the volume would be published in Rome as soon as possible.

- *Rapid Communications* had not been published as there had been no material.

- SIO had enrolled 35 new members since the last Symposium: Japan, Germany & USA were particularly well represented in the membership. There had been 7 resignations. Many countries have only 1 or 2 members and more than 80 countries are not represented at all, notably the sub-Saharan countries of Africa.

Philip Corbet commented that the Abstracts were very valuable.

Acceptance of the Editor's Report was proposed by M. Schorr, seconded by K. Inoue & Carried.

## 7. Report of the Treasurer.

Copies of the Accounts were handed out (and are attached to these Minutes).

- Marianne Kiauta reported that the present financial situation was satisfactory although membership fees did not cover cost of *Odonatologica* and *Notulae Odonatologicae*.

There followed discussion on the possible repayment of the loan to SIO which had been made by the Kiautas in 1972 and it was suggested the new Council should address the matter. It was pointed out by the Kiautas that, since the affair of the Journals were now outside the SIO, the loan would stand, in order to maintain publication. Frieda Tchaikovsky asked what rate of interest was charged and Marianne told her it was 6%, the same as for a bank loan. Eberhard Schmidt suggested that the editorial accounts and the loan should henceforth be "out of discussion".

In answer to a question from Georg Rüppell about the high cost of reprints, the Treasurer explained that, since about 1983, the full cost of publication of reprints had been charged to those employed by a scientific institution but reduced or waived for 3rd World members and those who are not so employed.

Acceptance of the Treasurer's Report was proposed by H. Lohmann, seconded by K. Inoue & Carried.

## 8. Report of Scrutineer of Accounts.

Copies of the statement by Marcel Wascher were handed out (and one is attached to these Minutes).

Acceptance of the statement of satisfaction for the financial affairs was proposed by J.-G. Pilon, seconded by M. Kotarac & Carried.

## 9. Reports from the National/Regional Offices.

These were made by the National Representatives, if present or read by Bastiaan Kiauta, if not.

Canada: (J.-G. Pilon) No change since 1993

Germany: (M. Schorr) 4 numbers of *Hagenia* had been produced.

Iberia: (A. Cordero) Membership is low but slowly increasing. A yearly newsletter is produced which includes translations of papers, mostly from German, about Spanish Odonata. It is hoped to monitor regional literature and University research projects.

**India:** (R. Andrew) A newsletter *Fraseria*, has been produced with short research articles. There are plans for a 5th South Asian Symposium in 1996.

**Italy:** The newsletter *Lindenia* is produced promptly in January & June each year. There has been little change in membership; a *Hemianax* Monitoring Centre has been set up and maintained; Italian literature on Odonata is being monitored.

**Japan:** (K. Inoue) Japanese colleagues were much encouraged by the Osaka Symposium, such that membership has increased to 90 (more than any other country.).

**Slovenia:** (M. Kotarac) The second Number of a journal (*Exuviae*) is to come out in two weeks time. The main present task is a mapping project.

**UK:** (J. Silsby) There are 36 SIO members and *Kimminisia* has 42 contributors from UK & Commonwealth. Local SIO meetings are not necessary since the national Society (BDS), which has nearly 1400 members, meets locally for field excursions and for a yearly Members' Day. Various projects are undertaken and there is a strong habitat conservation programme.

**USA:** (M. May) There are 63 SIO members. The National Representative, Minter Westfall, answers questions and identifies specimens for members and also reviews papers and transmits them to Bastiaan Kiauta. Publication of *Selysia* is currently suspended (but see under Item 16). The Dragonfly Society of the Americas is increasing in membership. It regularly publishes a newsletter, *Agria* and the *Bulletin of American Odonatology*, and it holds frequent regional meetings and a largely informal annual meeting.

#### 10. Report from IUCN Species Survival Commission Representative.

- Norman Moore reported that the Odonata Specialists' Group Meeting was held on 20 August and that it had been open to all SIO members. It had been attended by 5 Representatives and 17 visitors.

- Tribute was paid to Tony Watson who had died in December 1993. Richard Rowe has replaced him as representative for Australia.

- Difficulties frequently encountered by odonatologists in obtaining permission to collect in National Parks would be taken up with Tim New and IUCN would be urged to take stronger action.

- Regional reports were given by Representatives of Japan, South Africa, Germany & Poland.

- For the Red List of Endangered Species, new quantified criteria would be used & a revised list produced, checked and submitted to IUCN.

- The Dragonfly Action Plan was amended after the Osaka meeting. Jan van Tol outlined achievements and proposals which were as follows:

- data would be collected on 10 taxonomically isolated spp. and on 4 spp. with unusual biology;

- conservation issues are urgent, so all concerned should press their governments to cooperate;

- special attention should be given to threatened centres of endemism (eg. S. China, the Philippines) and threatened taxonomically isolated spp.

- The future of the Group (which had now been existence for 15 years) was discussed: opportunities were limited

by lack of financial support but coordination with SIO regional/national groups would be helpful.

- Thanks were expressed to SIO for allowing integration with SIO Symposia and for publishing reports.

**Acceptance** of the Report was proposed by P. Corbet, seconded by W. Schneider & **Carried**.

#### 11. Report from the International Odonata Research Institute (IORI).

Mike May spoke on behalf of the Director, Minter Westfall who was unable to be present.

- Bill Mauffray continues to be General Manager.

- George & Juanda Bick are helping with the collections.

- In the past 2.5 years there had been 31 visitors from Germany, Brazil, Belgium, Hungary, the UK and the USA.

- Current assets are about \$3500, much of which has come from the sale of plastic envelopes (there are still some in stock).

- A grant of \$5000 had been awarded in 1994 for work on the endangered species *Cordulegaster sayi*: on completion (which is close) the money will be paid and most will remain in the IORI in exchange for administration of the grant.

- All running expenses are generously met by the Florida Dept of Agriculture & the Division of Plant Industry, in return for curation of the FSCA Odonata collection.

- More space is now needed, especially for the collections, and more cases. Plans have been drawn up and applications for grants have been submitted to build an extension, providing 3500 sq.ft. Better use of present space would be made by the installation of compactors in the "old museum" room early next month.

**Acceptance** of the Report was proposed by J. Ott, seconded by B. Kiauta & **Carried**.

It was agreed that the new Council should address the very important issue of the future of the IORI.

#### 12. Report of the Secretary of the 13th International Symposium of SIO.

Eberhard Schmidt reported on various problems that had been encountered.

In proposing **acceptance** of the Report, the Chairman thanked and congratulated all who had been involved in the organization of the Symposium. Seconded by J.-G. Pilon & **Carried**.

#### 13. Report of the Chairman of the Permanent Committee for Organization of International Symposia of Odonatology.

Bastiaan Kiauta announced that the 1997 Symposium would take place in Slovenia and that, for 1999, there was a choice between New York State, India and Peru.

**Acceptance** of the Report was proposed by E. Schmidt, seconded by K. Inoue & **Carried**.

#### 14. Discharge of the present council.

Proposed by W. Schneider, seconded by K. Inoue & **Carried**.

At this point there were no officers apart from the Chairman of the present Meeting, who thanked the retiring Council and Central Office for their work on behalf of members, and Bastiaan in particular for his leadership

over the past 20 odd years. The Chairman recommended that the past be put behind, that members should look to the future and then introduced "The Way Forward".

#### 15. Election of the new Council.

The following were nominated: President Elect: Kiyoshi Inoue; Secretary General: Martin Schorr; Second Secretary: Sid Dunkle; Ordinary Members of Council: Rob Cannings, Peter Miller, Jürgen Ott and Jan van Tol.

Jean-Guy Pilon, having been elected President Elect in 1993, did not need to stand for election at this meeting.

- The Chairman pointed out, in accordance with the results of the 1994 referendum, Bastiaan Kiauta would be editing SIO publications (apart from SELYSIA) and that no further action in this matter would be required from the Meeting. His other functions would be taken over by Council members and necessary changes to the Constitution would be proposed.

- Philip Corbet enquired about the appointment of a Treasurer and was reminded that this would be in the hands of the new Council.

There being no other nominations, the Chairman proposed the election of the nominees, seconded by N. Moore and Carried with one abstention.

#### 16. The way forward.

(I) In an introductory comment, the new President (Jean-Guy Pilon) said that the newly-elected Council members hoped to do their best to assist in the plans which would be put forward in the next two years to shape the SIO in accordance with the needs to today's generation.

(II) Bastiaan Kiauta urged all to go for the future with enthusiasm and trust and he assured the Meeting that, as agreed under Option 1 of the Referendum, he himself would be concerned only with scientific aspects and could promise regular publication of SIO journals as heretofore. He appealed for help from members by sending manuscripts, especially for *Notulae Odonatologicae*.

(III) Wolfgang Schneider informed the meeting that had been appointed by the Council to chair the Working Group with the aim of preparing and amended Constitution. He spoke warmly to the need of safeguard the future of the SIO in a spirit of reconciliation, and appealed for full support from members. He outlined the following plan:

(i) the December 1995 issue of *Odonatologica* would contain a summary of progress thus far. A form would be included for interested members to fill in an return, with their ideas for change: the deadline being January '96.

Those members who responded could, should they so wish, be included in the process of constructing an amended Constitution and together they would make up the Working Group under Wolfgang's chairmanship;

(ii) the Working Group would then formulate a revised version of the Constitution which would be published in a preliminary form (for comments and suggestions from the membership in the June 1996 *Selysia*).

(iii) a final version would be prepared for publication in the December 1996 issue of *Selysia* for acceptance later at the 1997 Symposium. Thus all changes would be made in accordance with the present Constitution.

In the discussion that followed, it was clear that members saw the plan as very promising, with appeal to the new younger members whom the Society needed to attract and retain. Philip Corbet welcomed it and said he was heartened by what was proposed and that it was a promising blueprint for the future. He said it was important the group invite participation from members (perhaps including Mike Parr) to ensure democratic decision-making and recommended Constitution Article 9 be strictly adhered to.

- Philip then proposed a motion "that the existing Constitution of SIO, whether or not it is subsequently amended, be respected by all members of SIO". This was seconded by M. May & G. Rüppell & Carried unanimously. One of the Minute Recorders, on a point of clarification, remarked that the motion was somewhat ambiguous; PSC agreed but felt that, even so, it covered the present needs.

(IV) Andreas Martens announced the formation of three more Special Topic Groups. All such groups would consist of small international teams, each concentration on a particular topic, which would be set up immediately, but would await formal recognition until the next Symposium:

► Climatic Change: Coordinator: Jürgen Ott

► African Odonata: Coordinator: Andreas Martens

► Calopteryx: Coordinator: Georg Rüppell

Prospective groups' members would be reached via *Selysia*.

(Sheets were passed round on which members could sign up if interested and the lists would be sent to the respective coordinators).

(V) Martin Schorr (Secretary General) proposed to take over publication of *Selysia* with the aim of developing better communication between members, it would continue to be the SIO Newsletter and would include sections on:

- SIO management, news, regular reports of National Offices, Special Topic Groups, IORI, etc.;

- review articles on Odonatology in various parts of the world, each issue covering a different region;

- technical papers on odonatological fields not covered by other journals (e.g. ethno-odontology, dragonflies in folklore, poetry, music, as human food, etc.). It was hoped the first issue would come out in June 1996 and would contain selected articles on Odonata in Africa; anyone interested in contributing should contact Martin.

The Chairman pointed out that *Selysia* would be in the hands of the new Council and the Constitution Working Group and that its financial arrangements would need to be looked into by these bodies.

(VI) Mladen Kotarac introduced the 1997 Symposium which would be held at Maribor, Slovenia. He promised to provide the conditions necessary for good communication between members, good scientific presentations and the best atmosphere in which to decide the future of SIO.

17. A.O.B. (i) Jill Silsby was thanked for so ably conducting the meeting.

(ii) Wolfgang Schneider expressed regret for a letter he had written to Eberhard Schmidt and which he had circulated to members. He withdrew the sentiments expressed therein.

(iii) Rainer Rudolph, a member of the Symposium Organizing Committee, wished to thank so many for attending and for their offers to help. He apologized for the absence of the valuable plenary session, as conducted by Philip Corbet at previous symposia. He was deeply obliged for words of reconciliation and hope for the future.

On a motion from Jean-Guy Pilon, seconded by Philip Corbet, the Meeting adjourned at 17.47 hours.

#### **REORGANISATION OF SIO**

Dear members of SIO,

For several years the Council of SIO has been discussing changes to the Constitution of our Society. Changes became a No. 1 priority when the results of the 1995 Referendum became known and "Option 1" came into force (Option 1 is printed as a footnote on page 1 of this number of SELYSIA.) In the light of this, and of other changes that have occurred since the foundation of SIO more than two decades ago, it has become evident that the Society needs to be set on a radically new structural basis.

At the final meeting of the previous Council, Wolfgang Schneider was appointed to chair a Working group with the aim of preparing an amended Constitution. At the Essen Meeting Wolfgang (on behalf of Council) agreed that alterations would be made in strict accordance with the rules laid down by the present Constitution [see Minute 16 (III) (i), (ii) and (iii)]. The procedure to be adopted was put forward and various ideas were then discussed. The plan was welcomed by all members attending the meeting. Unfortunately, the time schedule outlined in the Business Meeting could not be kept.

Proposals in a general form, are now being prepared for distribution to interested members. Any member willing to contribute to the reorganization of our So-

cietiy is invited to ask for this draft document and to comment on it. We are interested in, and depend on, your constructive criticism! We also expect, and will take into consideration, opinions and proposals totally different from those in our document. The Working group will collect all proposals, discuss them, and prepare a preliminary version of a new Constitution; this draft will be circulated for comment from those who made suggestions. A final version will then be published in the February 1997 SELYSIA, for acceptance at the 1997 Business Meeting.

In essence the proposals aim at including the following:

- a) As a result of the adoption of Option 1, Articles VI and VII of the Constitution (Publications and Finance & Property), plus all By-laws mentioning *Odonatologica* and those dealing with Fees and Finances, will have to be totally rewritten.
- b) The Constitution and its By-laws should be tightened up to become more concise.
- c) The By-laws should be worded in a way to ensure a clear allocation of responsibilities within the Council.
- d) The number of members in the Council of SIO should be reduced.
- e) Democratic elements in the decision-making processes should be simplified.
- f) A clause could possibly be inserted allowing for the employment of a salaried manager should such a position ever be deemed necessary and should sufficient funds become available.

Dear Members, please participate in our deliberations on the future of SIO. Kindly send one of us your request for the draft document. As odonatologists we can assume political responsibility for peace in a very basic sense: beyond national/political borders and across continents, societies such as SIO promote and encourage personal contacts and friendships - thus making a small but valuable contribution to peace on earth!

We end with a small request: At present SIO finds itself in a difficult position. In order to reorganize the Society, we must depend on financial support from members and/or sponsors. If you wish to help, and have the means to do so, kindly send us a donation to the new SIO account in Germany (Treasurer of SIO, Heiner Lohmann, account no 218 0222 with Sparkasse Rheinfelden, BLZ 683 500 48), or enclose a bank-note in hard currency with your correspondence.

## CONSIDERATIONS FOR THE FOUNDATION OF UNION OF SOUTH AMERICAN ODONATOLOGISTS

In a letter to South American odonatologists the biologist Joachim Hoffmann, Museo de Historia Natural, Universidad Nacional Mayor San Marcos, Lima (Peru) proposed a meeting in 1997, to discuss the foundation of Union of South American Odonatologists.

J. Hoffmann during numerous conversations with South American colleagues gained the impression that many odonatologists wished for stronger contacts and a better communication-platform. Because of the economic situation of many South American odonatologists, it is only rarely possible to participate in conferences on other continents. Therefore it would be beneficial to set up, in South America itself, a better organizational structure. J. Hoffmann sent a questionnaire to his South American colleagues and submitted suggestions on how to improve communication between odonatologists in South America.

1. Publication of a newsletter.
2. Publication of a scientific odonatological journal for South America. Papers should be written in the native language or in English. Until the formation of such a union, J. Hoffmann would organize the production of this journal.

3. Organization of a conference of South American odontology in Venezuela in 1997.
4. Discussion of the foundation of the Union of South American Odonatologists.

STATEMENT

I was invited by Mrs M. KIAUTA to examine her financial administration for the period July 1, 1993 through June 24, 1995, which I did on 25 June 1995.


Likewise, I have checked the 1994 REFERENDUM blanks, as returned by the SIO members up to and inclusive 8 May 1995.

I have to report the following:

- (1) All responding members have voted for "Option 1", as defined in the referendum circular of 1 June 1994, under (1), i.e. ODONATOLOGICA & NOTULAE are to be "produced outside the SIO financial control, responsibility and risk".
- (2) Although this provision was to be implemented on 1 January 1995, I was requested to examine the books and the accounts in the "traditional way", as hitherto done by the Society auditors in all the previous years, which I have done by means of a random test audit, along with the respective invoices and remittances. The records are correctly booked. All the income and expenditure are precisely documented.
- (3) With reference to provision (6), in the Minutes of the SIO Charter Meeting, "the fees should be defined annually to cover production costs" of ODONATOLOGICA, in the reported period, these were decidedly lower:  
Fees: NLG 120.110,81      Printer's bills: NLG 149.545,86  
i.e. the printer's bills were covered for ca 80.3% by the income from the fees. This does not include any other expenditures of day-to-day operation, etc., of which the postage alone amounted to NLG 29,377,50.  
The balance was mainly achieved through the income of the Antiquarian Department and other commercial sales. It is slightly positive (NLG 15.535,58). However, most 1995 fees were already paid, while printer's bills for the September and December issues of ODONATOLOGICA and NOTULAE were not yet received.  
The open liability remains also the 1972 starting loan (NLG 18.200,-) and the legal interest thereof.
- (4) I do note, there were fewer operations of the Antiquarian Department than in the Trevi-Osaka period, rendering a ca 25% lower income. The reasons for this situation were stated to me, but they do not fall within the scope of my task.
- (5) The financial situation is basically identic to that in the Trevi-Osaka period, and it is considered sound.

In summary, the balance account, the books and the respective documentation are perfectly in order. I am, therefore, suggesting a MOTION OF THANKS to Mrs M. Kiauta, for the (not easy) job she has performed during the Osaka-Essen period.
